

# OLD IVANHOE GRAMMARIANS' ASSOCIATION GRANT GUIDELINES & APPLICATION FORM

## The OIGA Grants Program is designed to:

- Encourage more alumni to connect with the OIGA
- Support, strengthen and develop stronger ties between Life Members of the OIGA
- Endorse the value of becoming an OIG Life Member to students and alumni
- Provide financial support to individual past students, OIG Groups, OIG Clubs, Charities and Organisations owned / managed by alumni
- Ensure alumni are actively working with the OIGA to achieve its aim to *reach, connect and support current and past students*

## Conditions and process of application:

- Only Life Members of the Old Ivanhoe Grammarians' Association can apply for a Grant
- Individuals / Clubs / Groups / Charities / Organisations (CGCO) may only apply for a Grant once in a calendar year
- The OIGA Grant application form must be completed in full, addressing every relevant question in the application. The application form is divided into 3 main sections:
  - Individual applicants (e.g. an alumni seeking a sponsorship for him/herself for a particular reason such as a charity event)
  - A sporting club / a theatrical group / an affiliated charity (e.g. a club seeking sponsorship)
- Applicants may wish to provide supporting documentation to help their proposal
- Clubs or other bodies seeking annual sponsorship may be requested to re-submit their application (or part thereof) on an annual basis
- All applicants MUST sign the declaration (page 8) and attach to their application
- Once granted, the individual / CGCO will be asked to report back to the OIGA regarding how the grant was used and how it assisted the OIGA in achieving its aim to *reach, connect and support current and past students*
